If you have a "My number" card (individual number ID card for social security and tax records) with a picture, you can obtain an official document such as *Jyumin-hyo* (resident certificate) at convenience stores. This issuance service will be temporarily suspended all day on Mon., Oct. 19, for system maintenance. You can obtain certificates such as Jyumin-hyo at ward offices or Gyosei Service Corners.

Have You Submitted the 2020 Population Census Form?

This is the year of the Population Census, which is conducted every five years. The population Census is a statistical survey that is conducted according to the law and covers everyone living in Japan, regardless of nationality. You are legally required to respond. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the form will basically be put into mailboxes this year. You can answer the questionnaire

either on line or by sending the form back by postal mail.

Deadline: October 7 (Wed) *If you haven't participated by the deadline, the questionnaire form will be put in your mailbox again in Mid-October. Please send the filled out form back by postal mail if you haven't reply by then.

Financial Support for School Fees: Preparation Fees for Entering Elementary School

Financially disadvantaged families with children who go to municipal elementary schools in Yokohama may be eligible to receive financial assistance to help cover the costs for items such as school supplies and school trips. Financial support fees for entering elementary

school will be paid in December. Those who are

eligible, please be sure to apply.


