National Pension Plan: Special Payment System for Students

This is a financial support system for students whose last year's income was less than the amount set by



than the amount set by the city they reside in. You may be exempted from payment of National Pension premiums, if you submit an application. Even if you have been getting this exemption since last year, if you would like to continue receiving this exemption, you need to apply again this year. Application: If you received an application post card, fill in the card and submit or mail it to the Japan Pension service. To apply for the first time, go to your local ward office's National Pension Plan Section (Kokumin Nenkin Kakari). Please bring your student ID card, your pension book, and your seal (inkan). If you sign the application yourself, your personal seal (inkan) is not required.

Subsidy for Pneumococcal Vaccination

The city of Yokohama subsidizes a part of the cost of the pneumococcal vaccination if you are turning 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, or 100 years old in the 2020 fiscal year. The notice should be

mailed to those who are eligible at the end of June. **Eligibility:** Those who have never had pneumococcal



vaccination before and are turning 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, or 100 years old in the 2020 fiscal year. Those who are between 60 and 65 years old who have a functional problem in their heart, kidney, the respiratory system, or immune function problem due to HIV that is equivalent to a 1st grade disability.

Fee: 3,000 yen *Please bring your health insurance card. *Reduction and exemption system apply for resident tax-free family or those on who are on welfare.

Notice from the Immigration Services Agency

There was a notice from the Immigration Services Agency of Japan, dated March 10, regarding the period of validity of the Certificate of Eligibility. Due to the various circumstances associated with the effects of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the Certificate of Eligibility that is normally valid for "3 months" will be treated as valid for "6 months" for the time being. With this treatment, you will be able to use the Certificate of Eligibility of within six months for visa applications* and landing applications.

*Please note: It is necessary to apply for a visa at a diplomatic mission abroad. If you intend to use a Certificate of Eligibility which 3 months or longer time has passed since its issuance date at the time of applying for the issuance of a visa at the diplomatic mission abroad, you will be required to submit document from your accepting organization indicated that they are still accepting you in the form of the contents of the activities given at the time of your application for the issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility.

Notice from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare

Even when the new coronavirus (COVID-19) has caused a decrease in business for a company, foreign workers are not allowed to be treated less favorably than Japanese workers just because they are foreigners.

(1) Companies must pay a **leave allowance** to foreign workers as well as Japanese when they are forced to take days off from work by the company.

(2) The **subsidy** the national government pays companies to protect workers can be used for foreign workers as well as Japanese.

(3) When foreign workers take days off from work because their child's school is closed, they can take **paid leave** just like Japanese workers.

(4) Companies cannot fire foreign workers freely. When a company is intending to fire their workers, **the same rules should apply for both Japanese and foreign workers.**

If you need help or have concerns, consult your local labour bureau, labour standards supervision office or public employment security office (Hello Work).
