Special Cash Payments by Yokohama City

Have you made an application for Special COVID-19 related Cash Payments? The deadline is September 10 (Thu).

Those who have your name on the

Basic Resident Resister in Yokohama on April 27, 2020 can receive 100,000 yen.



The application form is sent to the householder. Please check the details written on the form, put your seal or sign on it and write the bank account you want the money paid into. You also need a document that certifies your bank account such as a copy of your bank book and a copy of a document that shows your identity. Insert those documents in the return envelope and mail via a post office drop box. Please be careful that on the form in box(es) of person(s) eligible for the payment, only check the box(es) if you do NOT wish to receive payments. Applications are not accepted at Ward Administration Offices or City Hall. Please submit your application by mail.

Temporary Special Benefit for Low-Income Single-Parent Families

This is temporary special benefit by national government as one of COVID-19 related support measures.

1. Basic Benefit

Eligibility: (1) Those receiving Child Rearing Allowance in June, 2020, (2) Those receiving public pensions and not receiving any Child Rearing Allowance in June, 2020, or (3) Those whose income is at the same level as those receiving Child Rearing Allowance because of the effect of COVID-19. Benefit Amount: 50,000 yen per household, 30,000 yen per child from the second child

To Apply: Those who are currently receiving Child Rearing Allowance will receive a notice. Those who need to apply shall apply according to guidance shown on the Yokohama City's Website.

2. Additional Benefit

Eligibility: Those under either (1) or (2) for the basic benefit whose income has decreased because of the effect of COVID-19.

Benefit Amount: 50,000 yen per household

To Apply: When you submit a report of your present circumstances for continuous Child Rearing Allowance which you need to submit by the end of August, apply by declaring your financial situation.

Renewal of Special Transportation Tickets (1) Fukushi Tokubetsu Josha-ken

By August 31, notification will be sent out by regular mail.

(2) Fukushi Taxi tickets

By August 31, taxi tickets will be sent out to those eligible by registered mail.

Eligibility: Those who have a pass/taxi tickets valid till September and are eligible to renew it from October. If you wish to apply for one of (1)(2)(*you can't apply for both) for the first time, please contact Fukushi Hoken Center (Health and Welfare Center) of the ward you live in.

*Fukushi Tokubetsu Josha-ken is a pass for the municipal buses, municipal subways, and for the Kanazawa Seaside Line.

municipalities. Check the following evacuation/Meteorological information and advised action depending on the warning level.

Warning level 1: Early advisory. Be in a state of readiness.

Warning level 2: Heavy rain/flooding advisory. Verify evacuation routes.

Warning level 3: Evacuation preparation. Evacuate elderly and other persons requiring assistance.

Warning level 4: Evacuation orders/advisories. Full evacuation. Warning level 5: Disaster-level. Take optimal measures to save lives.

Beehive: Find and Exterminate in Early Stage

Beehives are formed in spring and get big in a short period of time in summer. The number of bees increase as it goes on. Take a measure before that time. Effort, and the danger increase for getting it removed as the size increases.

Locations beehives tend to be made: attic, in the wall, under the eaves, in the storage box for storm-shutters, bushes, and so on. *Contact your local ward office in the following situation:

- 1. Want to know how to get rid of long-legged paper wasp's hive
- 2. Want to rent protective clothing
- 3. Want to know bee exterminators.

Please note that your local ward office will NOT exterminate beehives.

COVID-19 Contact Confirming Application

COCOA is an app developed by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, that informs you if you have been in close contact with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Here is how this app

works:

1 Download COCOA

- 2 COCOA memorizes all others' smartphone information when you have close contact (individuals whom you are close contact with for more than 15 minutes and contact within approximately 1 meter)
- **3** Those who have tested "positive" will register on your COCOA that you have been close to people infected with COVID-19.
- **4** COCOA notifies those who have been in close contact with this COVID-19 carrier in the past 14 days.

5 COCOA will tell you if you should go to a medical institution or not. *COCOA is via Bluetooth, and it will NOT require people's name and telephone number. NO GPS. The government will NOT collect data. **URL** (the Ministry of Health,

Stores to Charge for Plastic Bags from July 1

This comes in line with the government's plan to oblige retailers across Japan to charge fees for plastic bags from July 1. It is to reduce plastic waste through charging fees for their plastic bags and to promote the use of reusable shopping bags. Plastic bags containing at least 25% of biomass materials are excluded from the charging requirement.
